**Project**

**Description:** This is a planned stormwater retrofit project that will consist of replacement of the existing stormwater conveyance system with the installation of new storm drain piping, an active stormwater treatment system and an aboveground storage tank. The limit of disturbance is approximately 56,760 square feet and is anticipated to begin construction in 2025.

The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked by staff of the NH Natural Heritage Bureau and/or the NH Nongame and Endangered Species Program for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government.

It was determined that, although there was a NHB record (e.g., rare wildlife, plant, and/or natural community) present in the vicinity, we do not expect that it will be impacted by the proposed project. This determination was made based on the project information submitted via the NHB Datacheck Tool on 7/25/2024 3:39:04 PM, and cannot be used for any other project.

Based on the information submitted, no further consultation with the NH Fish and Game Department pursuant to Fis 1004 is required.
